Onsite & Remote Learning

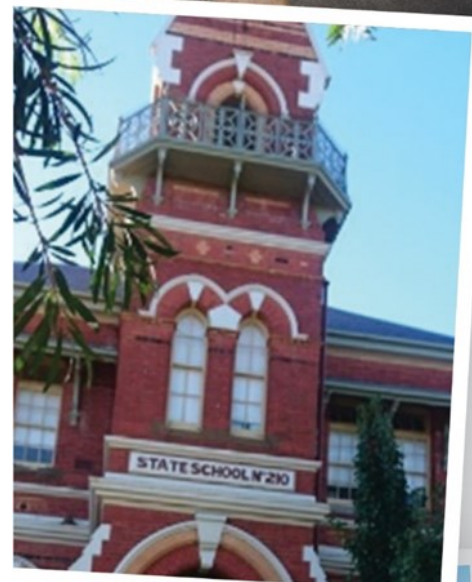
This week Monday October 11th:

In the Classroom:

Grade 1/2: This week grade 1/2s have been learning all about fairy tales. Students have been planning and writing their own fairy tales as well as reading lots of stories too. In Maths students have been learning all about measurement, learning how to measure the length of objects using informal units. What an awesome first week back we have had! Well done Grade 1/2s!

CHINESE

Grade Prep

The students revised the greeting words in Chinese. They started to sing a song "Two Tigers" in Chinese.

Grade One and Two

The students have been learning about 8 fruits words in Chinese, such as píng guǒ (apple), xiāng jiāo (banana), cǎo méi (strawberry), xī guā (watermelon), lí (pear), jú zi (mandarin), pú táo (grape), yòu zi (grapefruit). They also learn to how to describe colours of the fruits.

Grade Three and Four

Grade 3&4 students revised family member words and occupation words in Chinese. They learned to describe their family members' occupations in Chinese.

Grade Five and Six

Grade 5&6 students revised the meaning of the colours of the Peking Opera masks. They design and colour in their own Peking Opera masks.

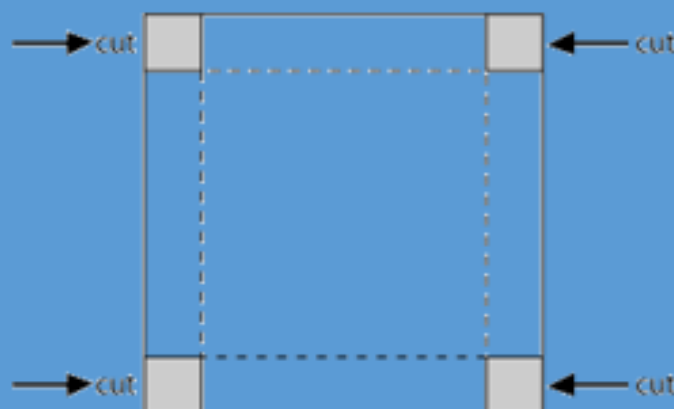
Maths At Home (M.A.F.)

Each week we present a maths challenge for you to complete with your child at home. The idea is for you to have fun engaging with your child's learning in mathematics. This week there will be a prize for anyone who attempts the maths at home challenge as well as the prize for the overall winner.



Making Boxes (Challenge 21)

Start with some sheets of squared paper measuring 15×15 cm square. Use them to make little boxes without lids. You do this by cutting out 1×1 cm squares at the corners and then folding up the sides. (The dotted lines in the diagram indicate the folds.)



Begin by cutting one square out of each corner. Fold up the sides. What is the size of the base? How high are the sides? So what is its volume?

Now cut a 2×2 cm squares out of each corner and fold up the sides.

Does it look as if it holds more than the first box less than the first box or just the same amount?

What is the size of the base now? How high are the sides now? So what is its volume?

Now cut a 3×3 cm square out of each corner and fold up the sides.

Does it look as if it holds more than the other boxes, less than the other boxes or just the same amount?

What is the size of the base now? How high is it now? So what is its volume?
