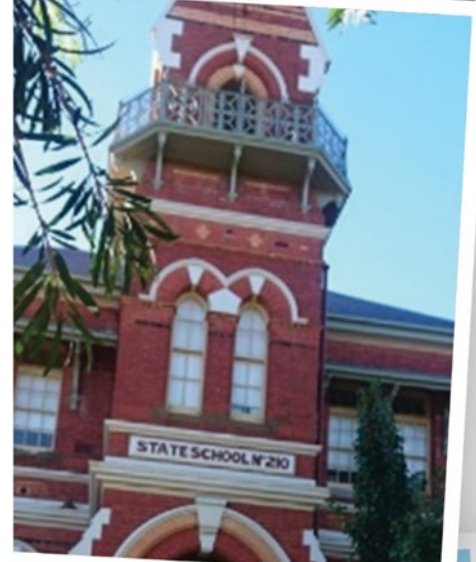

The Six Pile Sum

There is a pack of cards numbered from 1 to 20.

Arrange the cards into six piles where the totals of each pile are the same.



How could the cards be arranged?

Try to find another arrangement.

Note that the piles do not need to have the same number of cards.

Preps: choose the playing cards A (1) up to 10. Shuffle. Turn over one card, turn over another card and place it before or after the first card, depending on the order. Continue until you have turned over 4 cards. Write what you have done and bring this to school.
