From the Classroom:

Prep with Monique and Sophie

This week in the prep room, students were learning to make personal connections to something that happened in a story they have read. Students had to notice something in a story that made them think of something similar that has happened to them. For example, the boy in the story fell off the swing and it made me think of a time I fell off the trampoline. In writing, students continued to write recounts, focusing on including interesting words (e.g. **rainy** Monday, **delicious** breakfast). In maths, students have continued to learn a new strategy 'doubles facts' (e.g. $2+2=4$, $6+6=12$). Students have been challenging themselves to get quicker at recalling their 'doubles facts' so ask your students what are some 'double facts'. For inquiry, students had their last lesson about weather. Students learnt how it rains and did an experiment using water, shaving foam and food colouring to make their own rain cloud and watch it rain. Lastly, we have sent home reader books for students to read over the holidays and we hope everyone has a wonderful break!

Grade 1/2 with Amber and Ellie

We have come to the end of a very busy term in the 1/2 area. We have completed our learning on recounts in reading and writing and are looking forward to visiting Fairy tales next term. In maths the children have been completing worded problems based on fractions. They have been using representing halves and quarters. In late October of 2022 Taylor released her tenth album *Midnight*. This album symbolized her eras and older albums, leading up to the Eras Tour. This album represents Taylor's restless nights, anxiety, insecurity and insomnia. *Midnight* got famous the day it released, its one of Taylor's most popular albums and it's loved by all ages. Lana Del Rey and Ice Spice were even featured on the album. Lana Del Rey was in "Snow on the Beach" and Ice Spice was in "Karma" in the "Midnight" (The Untill Dawn Version) (From the Vault!).

Taylor always had a massive passion for music and she started writing her own songs at twelve! She wrote about things she experienced and knew about like love, hugs, friends and illness in her life. Taylor released her debut album in 2006. This album was a sensational hit and had one of her most iconic songs like "Should've said no" and "Picture to burn". She then released "Fearless" which once again, Amazing album like always! Taylor released this in 2008. This album got a VMA award for "You belong with me" which sadly got ruined by Kanye. Fearless being released helped fans get more into Taylor.
