Helping your child develop literacy skills through technology at home:

Daisy the Dinosaur jumps for computer coding (suitable for Prep-Year 4)

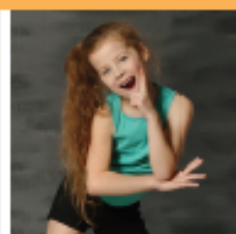
